It is very simple to participate. Here is how it works. Birdies for Charity is a pledge-based program based on the number of birdies made by the PGA Tour professionals during tournament week (June 18th through 24th). For example: if a donor pledges \$0.01 and 1,500 birdies are made, then that individual is asked to make a \$15.00 donation, of which 100% is given directly to our school. Donors also have the option of making a flat donation to the charity.

The donor that correctly guesses the number of birdies that will be made during the 2012 Travelers Championship wins a \$1,000 CASH gift card. Other prizes include 2 tickets to the World Golf Hall of Fame and IMAX Theatre, 2 tickets to the Ryder Cup, and a foursome at TPC River Highlands! (Hint---last year's correct birdie number was 1,839).
